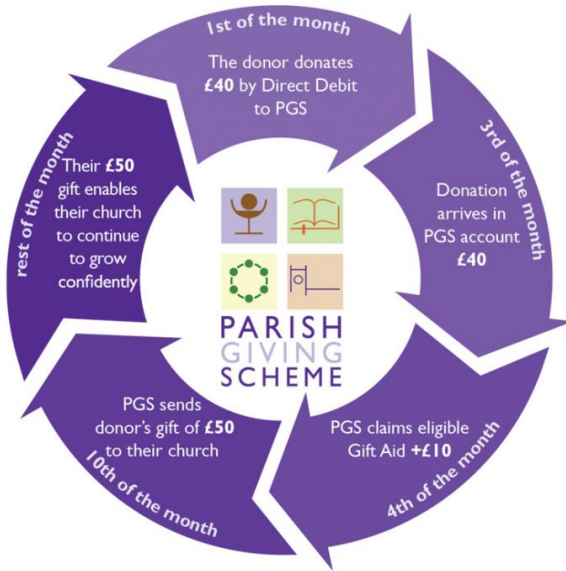


## How to give

Church members give in many different ways to suit their individual finances.

We have found the simplest and most efficient method by far is to use the Parish Giving Scheme.



There is a leaflet available in the church on the scheme but very simply, it is operated by the diocese at no cost to the church. The diocese also makes the monthly reclaim of Gift Aid for us in respect of the members of the congregation who have notified us they are UK taxpayers.

If you are a UK taxpayer you can use Gift Aid to increase the value of your gift to us by filling in a Gift Aid envelope alongside any of the methods, shown opposite.
